It was reported that the programs in Physical Therapy and Occupational Therapy were held up at the *ministère de l'Éducation, du Loisir et du Sport (MELS)* by the need to have the *ministère de la Santé et des Services sociaux (MSSS)* approve the move to a master's-level entry to the two professions. He further reported that the *Comité des vice-recteurs aux affaires académiques (VRAA)* of the *Conférence des recteurs et des principaux des universités du Québec (CREPUQ)* has approved a new evaluation and approval procedure for new program proposals that would modify the training leading to professional certification. Henceforth, such proposals will be submitted to CREPUQ's *Commission d'évaluation des projets de programmes (CEP)* while still at an exploratory stage (at a stage of development that includes *opportunité* considerations), so that an *Avis* can be formulated, before the whole new-program dossier is developed.

(Secretary's note: *the whole external evaluation process for the five newly approved new program proposals (from date of submission to date on letter of approval from the Minister, was as follows:*

- *Ph.D. in Educational Studies: one year and eight months.*

- *PT and OT programs: three years and nine months. The 88-credit master's program approved by APPC and Senate was withdrawn.)*

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**06.04 Subcommittee on Courses and Teaching Programs (SCTP)**

## a) SCTP membership (Arts replacement) (06-APPC-11-29)

APPC considered the recommendation to replace Professor Patrick Neilson of the Faculty of Arts with the Associate-Dean (Academic) of that Faculty to the APPC Subcommittee on Courses and Teaching Programs for a term extending from 1<sup>st</sup> January 2007 to 31<sup>st</sup> August 2009. The SCTP has in the past included an Associate Dean (Academic) from the Faculty of Agricultural and Environmental Sciences. It was cautioned that upper-level governance committees should not turn into administrative committees.

APPC approved the appointment of Associate-Dean (Academic) Mary McKinnon of the Faculty of Arts to the SCTP.

## b) CCE rewording of diploma for Diploma in Management (06-APPC-11-30)

APPC considered and **approved a recommendation submitted by the Senate Committee on Continuing Education to reword the diploma for the Diploma in Management of the Centre for Continuing Education, so that it indicates a student's concentration specifically on the diploma.** The request came from the students. The Dean of the Faculty of Management expressed agreement with the suggested rewording. It was noted that in all faculties except Engineering (where the name of the Department is included on the degree), the diploma includes only the name of the Faculty.
