#### **GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS**

#### Who can apply?

Prospective interns must take into account the following requirements:

- Must be at least 18 years old.
- Applicants must submit: a letter stating why they are interested in this internship, a completed Nexos Comunitarios' Personal Information form, and 3 references (1 must be academic). Ask for the forms by sending an email to: info@nexos.org.pe.

PMUNITATION tinterns cannot be on academic probation while patricipa นิกผูมการสหตุ นิกระชกหิค่า placement. Certain positions require specific skill sets and areas of study.

- Prospective interns are able to contact former interns, upon request.
- Suitable candidates will be invited for a telephone or Skype interview.
- Within 5 days after the interview, if accepted, the prospective intern will receive via email an invitation letter to participate in the program. Forms that require a signature will be included with the acceptance letter (i.e. Nexos Comunitarios Commitment of Ethics and Integrity)
- Prospective interns have 3 weeks to submit all documents and reserve their position with a 20% deposit of the internship fee. Remaining fees are due 8 weeks before arrival.
- The Length of the Summer eNCounter Program is 10 weeks.

#### Location

Urubamba (Sacred Valley of the Incas), Cusco, Peru. Participants will travel to the communities we work with Media Luna, Cuncani (located in Urubamba, Cusco) and Choquecancha (Lares, Cusco).

### Language of instruction

Nexos Comunitarios' coordinators and supervisors speak English, but a basic level of Spanish is necessary to participate in the program. Depending on the skills of the prospective participant, the language requirement could be dismissed.

# **Projects**

eNCounter participants will be able to learn from each of Nexos Comunitarios projects. For 2017, the projects are:

- The ecological Composting Toilets in Cuncani (Hygiene and sanitation);
- Family greenhouses in Cuncani (Agriculture and Nutrition);
- Experiential Tourism Circuit in Cuncani (Economic Empowerment);
- The application of Multidimensional Poverty Index in the community of Cuncani (Poverty measure research).
