Part-time "loads" for the 2010 and 2009 terms includes: part-time, Continuing Education, leave of absence, no credits, thesis half-time and unknown time status. The pre-200209 legacy term (pre-Banner) includes: part-time, Continuing Education, session of admission, thesis continuing, session of graduation, half-time, and leave of absence.

As of fall 2004, the non resident exchange students are reported under full-time "load".

These statistics are based on student's first and second departments within the primary and secondary curricula.

Departments are grouped within affiliated faculty, based on the Organization Unit table.
