A minimum of 5\$ donation is required for admission.

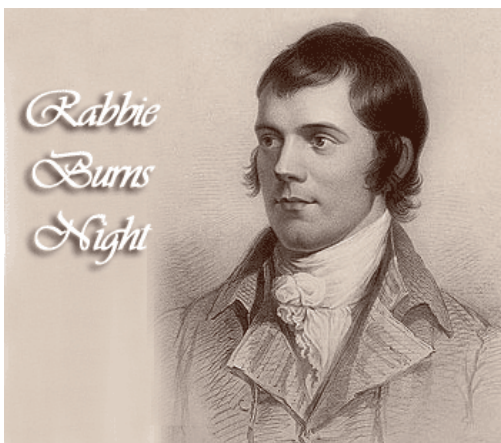
