

Following is information for residents doing their rotation in Ormstown:

On call:

OR: 24-hour availability while here. It is up to you to know what is going on.

ER: 1 weekend per month of a 12 hrs day Saturday or Sunday and a 12 hrs night either Friday, Saturday or Sunday. You can take this on the same weekend or split it in two weekends. 08:00 p.m. to 8:00 a.m. = 1 night per week. This does not include a Friday night. You should not work the following day.

NB: Please make sure to give a copy of your on call schedule to Dr. Geukjian.

- A surgical clinic is held Friday and Saturday for "lumps & bumps", vasectomies etc. If you are interested, talk it over with the surgeons and make sure arrangements are made with the secretaries at the OMC to accommodate the change in schedule.
- Surgery is done selectively on Tuesday and Thursdays. Back up:
In OMC: MD on 2nd call (see schedule) or any MD in clinic, especially if the patient is known by one of the MD's. Charts should be placed on the desk of the back up MD or on the desk of the MD with whom you discussed the case. In ER: MD assigned to the ER. Leave charts with that MD in the ER. When in the ER with MD's who do not admit patients (MH PSM, and locum MD's) difficult problems should be discussed with 2nd call MD, who is always one of the MD's of the OMC. Don't hesitate to communicate with the patient's own Family Doctor, to get background and advice. Follow up patients seen in the ER should be with their own Family Doctor. If he/she is not available, or if the patient does not have a GP, then have them make an appointment with you at the OMC. The patients you admit to the hospital should be rounded with the MD responsible. Your lab reports will be placed in a folder by the desk at the OMC. Make sure requisitions have a staff person's (Patient's Family Physician, or your OMC back up) initials on as well as yours.
- Formal case and topic discussion: 1/ month to the group (second Wednesday of your month) in OMC library usually at 7:30 a.m. (check with Dr. Geukjian) Every Wednesday at 12:00 p.m. there are ward rounds at the "nurses residence" – in the same building as your apartment, in the basement, actually directly beneath your apartment. The stairs are at your end of the passageway, the last door before the exit.
- You are also invited to our business meetings the first Wednesday of the month at 7:30 in the OMC library, as well as the committee on the evaluation of the medical acts which is held in the hospital (DPS' office the third Wednesday of the month at 8:00 a.m.).
- Since the community does not know you personally, it is recommended that you wear a lab coat while seeing patients.
