The School offers a professional graduate program leading to the M.Arch. (Professional) degree, with the opportunity to take either the 3-term, Design Studio-Coursework concentration, or the four-term Design Studio-Directed Research concentration. The Master of Architecture (Professional) is fully accredited by the Canadian Architectural Certification Board (CACB) and recognized as accredited by the National Council of Architectural Registration Boards (NCARB) in the United States. The School also offers research-oriented post-professional graduate programs leading to the Master of Architecture (Post-professional M.Arch.), and Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D.) degrees in a variety of areas, including History and Theory of Architecture, Cultural Mediations and Technology, and Urban Design and Housing.
