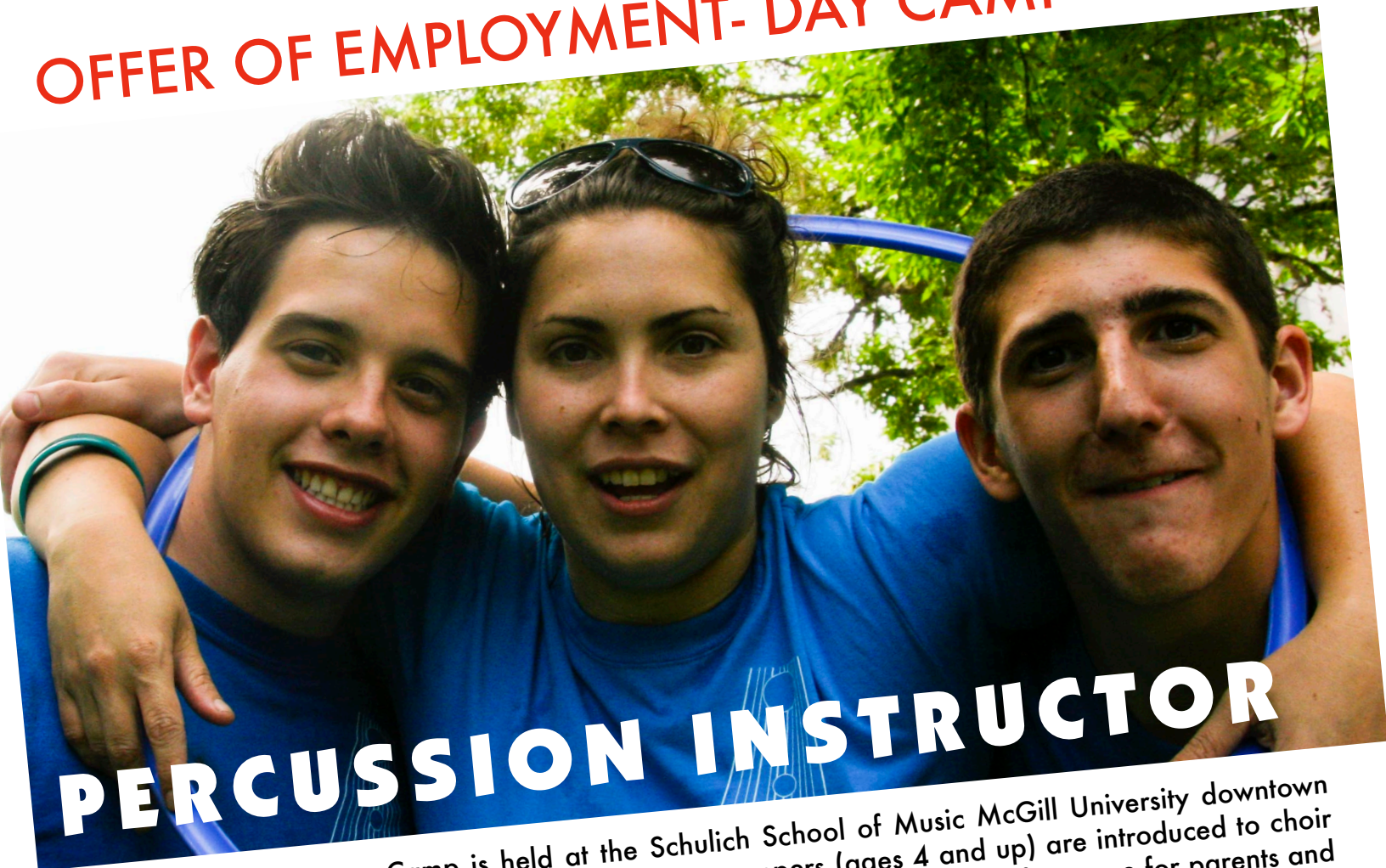


OFFER OF EMPLOYMENT- DAY CAMP
