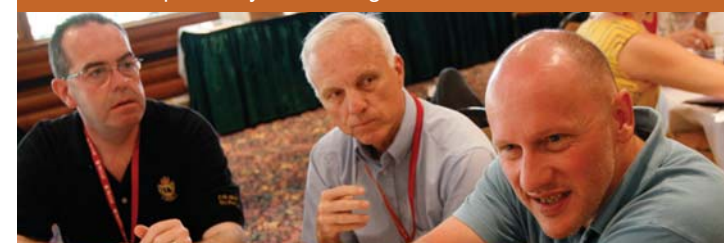

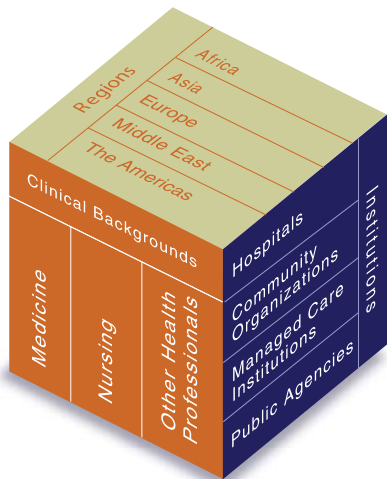


Innovation, excellence and leadership from McGill University's internationally renowned Faculties of Medicine and Management.

- Offers a tremendous opportunity to develop health leaders at the worldwide level by drawing on the international expertise of McGill's Faculties of Medicine and Management.

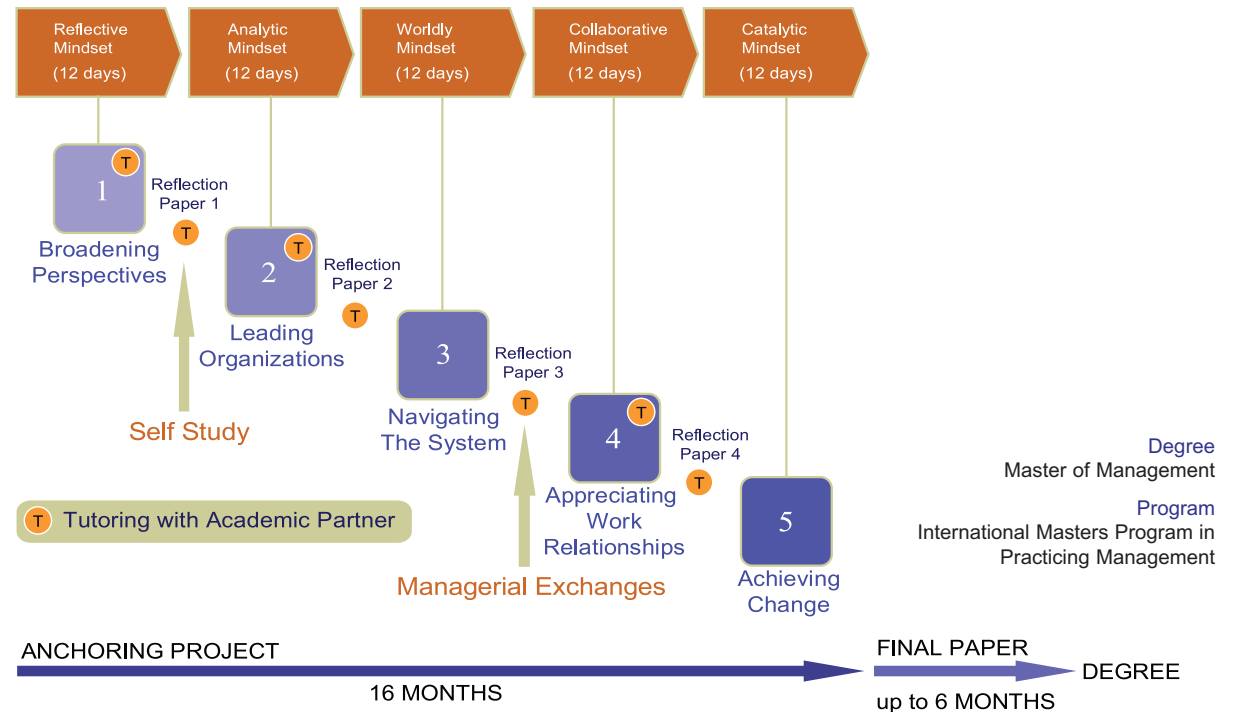
Inside the IMHL

Throughout the program, maximum learning is concentrated on the needs of individual participants and their respective organizations.

The program is delivered in five 12-day modules over a 16-month period, with each module corresponding to a specific "leadership mindset":

- Module 1: The Reflective Mindset – Broadening Perspectives
- Module 2: The Analytic Mindset – Leading Organizations
- Module 3: The Worldly Mindset – Navigating the System
- Module 4: The Collaborative Mindset – Appreciating Work Relationships
- Module 5: The Catalytic Mindset – Achieving Change

Other activities include an anchoring project, managerial exchanges, reflection papers, self-study, a final paper and tutoring.
