Objectives of the Course:

Building on Introductory Urdu, this course will improve students' ability to read, write, understand and speak the Urdu-Hindi language, introducing Devanagari ("Hindi") script in the second term. Students will be taught by means of in-class activities and lessons, demanding a high level of participation, as well as written and oral homework exercises and tests. By the end of the course students will have a grasp of the full range of Urdu-Hindi grammar. Students will be familiarized with aspects of South Asian culture connected with the language, and will be exposed to Urdu-Hindi journalism, poetry, television and film.
