### Remedium Al is expanding

Remedium AI, a company devoted to commercialize the research performed in Dr. Murgita's laboratory since 2010, has closed a 3M\$ seed round financing. The company will expand a unique software platform that is capable of rapidly identifying new potential drug candidates that will be cheaper to manufacture, with a special focus on oral deliverables. The technology developed in Dr. Murgita's lab employs a branch of artificial intelligence called machine learning. The company is exploring locations for its head office and intends to offer internships to McGill students with some bioinformatics knowledge through the MITACS Accelerate program in cooperation with two senior professors in the McGill Computer Science department. Remedium AI is the fourth startup company originating from Dr. Murgita's research at McGill.
