Montreal, March 25, 2009 – The McGill Symphony Orchestra, under the direction of Maestro Alexis Hauser will perform its final concerts of the season on April 3 and 4 at 7:00 p.m. in the Schulich School of Music's Pollack Hall. The program is dedicated to Father Fernand Lindsay, c.s.v, (1928-2009), who received an honorary doctorate from McGill in 2003, and will feature concerti performed by students Alexander Read (violin) and Keith Dyrda (trombone).

The program includes Beethoven's *Fidelio Overture*, Op. 72c, Mozart's *Violin Concerto No.3 in G major*, *K.216*, *Concertino for Trombone in E-flat major*, *Op. 4* by Ferdinand David, and Mozart's *Symphony No. 40 in G minor*, *K. 555*.
