

The **Birks Heritage Chapel** is located in the William and Henry Birks Building, 3520 University Street,  $2^{nd}$  floor. Permission may be given by the Dean of the Chapel for religious services, weddings, baptism/naming ceremonies, and memorial services to <u>members of the University community</u>. It should be noted that the Chapel is dedicated for Christian worship, **but** it may also be used by people of other faiths <u>within the McGill community</u>.

### **BAPTISMS/NAMING CEREMONIES IN THE CHAPEL**

The Birks Heritage Chapel is **available to the McGill University community only**; that is, faculty, students, alumni, staff members, and members of the McGill teaching hospitals. Where either of the parties is a member of a local church, its minister/priest should be consulted; he/she may be prepared to conduct the baptism/naming ceremony in the Chapel. For persons who do not have a community of worship in Montreal, the McGill University Chaplains may be asked to perform the service. A suggested list of Christian and Non-Christian ministers is attached.

### 1. <u>APPLICATION</u>

- (a) Bookings should be made as far in advance as possible, especially in the summer. *Tentative bookings will be held for a maximum of four (4) weeks only.* Please confirm your booking with the Chapel Coordinator. Office hours are on Wednesdays, 9:00–5:00.
- (b) The completed 'internal McGill University form' (see page 7), payment of the chapel fee, and all other required documents must be submitted to the Chapel Coordinator, (<u>chapel.relg@mcgill.ca</u>), 3520 University Street, room 102, as soon as possible together with the fees; or e-mailed to: <u>chapel.relg@mcgill.ca</u>.

# If the baptism (naming ceremony) is cancelled for whatever reason, and the forms and cheque have been sent and the chapel booked, there will be a <u>Cancellation Administration Fee</u> of \$100.00

For baptisms/naming ceremonies, a commemorative letter of the baptism celebration at the Birks Heritage Chapel, will be issued. *This is not a legal document*, however.

When returning the `Application for a Baptism to be Celebrated in the Birks Heritage Chapel' form, <u>kindly</u> <u>enclose</u> copy(ies) of `**Proof of Existence'**, e.g. Birth Certificate, passport, etc., <u>and</u> a copy of your McGill diploma or student card, etc., to show your connection with McGill University.

#### BASIC COST FOR THE USE OF THE CHAPEL:

Current McGill Students (part-time or full-time)	\$250.00 (Chapel and custodian fees) + taxes
Others	\$450.00 (Chapel and custodian fees) + taxes

Fees other than the Basic costs for the use of the Chapel are detailed in Appendix A.

### 2. **<u>TIME</u>**

Baptisms can be celebrated in the Chapel <u>only</u> when the building is not in use for academic purposes. During the academic session (September to April inclusive—fall and winter classes; and May to July inclusive—summer classes) this normally restricts the <u>use of the Chapel to Saturdays;</u> and <u>Sundays after 3 p.m.</u>

### 3. AMENITIES

Photographers are allowed; however, we suggest you discuss arrangements with the officiating minister.

Flowers may be placed on the table, altar, or on one or two of the wooden flower stands that are available, but **Chapel furnishings** <u>may not be moved or removed</u>.

It is forbidden to nail, tack or tape anything to the wood or the floors. Sticky tack (easy to apply and remove) may be used. If anything in the Chapel or the building is damaged you will be charged a 'Damage Fee' of \$200.

### 4. <u>ROMAN CATHOLIC SERVICES</u>

Families wishing to have their child/children baptised Roman Catholic at the Chapel, must contact the Newman Centre Chaplain. <u>Failure to do so will mean that the baptism will not be registered in any Catholic record</u> <u>book</u>. There is a fee payable to the Newman Centre for the preparation of the Catholic register. *For further information, please contact* the coordinator, Ms. Linda Diez at the Newman Centre, 3484 Peel Street, telephone (514) 398–4106, (514) 398–4107 or <u>newmancentre@mail.mcgill.ca</u>.

### 5. MINISTER

The name of the officiating minister must be specified on the application form.

- The contracting parties are responsible for discussing with the officiating minister all arrangements and his/her particular responsibilities.
- *Please note*: baptisms/naming ceremonies must start promptly, since other baptisms and/or weddings might be scheduled for the same day.

### 6. ORGAN

Should you decide to have organ music at your baptism/naming ceremony, the Birks Heritage Chapel Organist, Mr. Scott Bradford (B.Mus. (Toronto), M.Mus. (McGill)), *must be contacted first*. (He has the 'right to first refusal'.) Mr. Bradford can be reached at his new telephone # (as of October 14, 2015): (514) 951–2947 or via e-mail <u>scott.bradford1@sympatico.ca</u>. His fee is **\$150.00**, which is payable to him directly. (See Appendix B for more details.)

### **PIANO**

A piano which is tuned on a regular basis is available for use. If you wish to have the piano tuned specifically for your event, this can be arranged for an additional fee of \$150.00 (plus taxes).

You may bring in your own system (small) with speakers (if you wish to bring a CD or iPod).

<u>Alternate musicians</u> (as a suggestion) can be hired through McGill's Faculty of Music, Gig Office (514) 398–8157.

### 7. ARRANGEMENTS

You may view the Chapel Monday through Friday, between 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.; details of the service should be discussed with the officiating minister.

When approval has been given to the request for a baptism/naming ceremony in the Birks Heritage Chapel, the parties should discuss all further arrangements with the Chapel Coordinator, at (514) 398–4121 or chapel.relg@mcgill.ca).

### 8. **<u>HOURS</u>**

The Building and Chapel will be open approximately **one** (1) **hour before** the ceremony and approximately **one** (1) **and half** ( $1\frac{1}{2}$ ) **hours after** the ceremony (for example, if you wished to have a service at 12:00 p.m., then the use of the building/chapel would be between 11:00 a.m. and 1:30 p.m.).

### 9. FAMILY ROOM

The Senior Common Room (Room 100) is set aside for the use of the family during baptisms/naming ceremonies. This room is open at the same time that the building is available for the service. Please remember that the *officiating clergy is responsible for details of procedure, before, during and after the ceremony.* 

Please also note that alcoholic beverages are <u>not</u> allowed in the building, but you may bring non-alcoholic beverages (water) and light snacks.

### 10. PARKING

We are <u>not</u> able to provide parking for Chapel events. Please <u>contact</u> the McGill University Parking Services at 514–398–4559 for information about fees and arrangements for parking on campus, if necessary.

### 11. CAPACITY OF THE CHAPEL

The Chapel holds approximately **150 people**. There are eleven (11) pews on both sides of the chapel,  $2^{nd}$  floor, which seat approximately 6 to 8 people each. There is also a balcony on the  $3^{rd}$  floor, which seats approximately 30 people.



## William and Henry Birks Building

The building was constructed in 1931 of many high quality materials. Stadacona limestone covers the exterior and lends the facade, with its elegant fenestration, a feeling of mass and stability. The interior contains oak panelling, plaster mouldings, wrought iron, stained glass windows, and carved wood and stone Biblical imagery such as the lamb, the true vine, the rose of the passion, the dove, and the pelican. Although there is much ornamentation throughout, it is not superfluous; it accents the function of the building which currently houses the School of Religious Studies.

Two of the most interesting areas of the Birks' Building are the library, which is oak panelled and features pilasters on the walls, and the **Chapel** which **seats approximately 150 and spans two storeys**. Both rooms are well suited to their function. Each library window features a small stained glass emblem in its centre, yet still allows plenty of light to enter this working area. The chapel's height and narrowness give it a Gothic air. A large stained glass window of the Ascension dominates the west end and is accompanied by a series of smaller panels around the top of the nave. Because of these windows, only diffuse light enters this somewhat dim hall creating an aura of calm and serenity quite suitable to a Chapel.

The Birks' Building is one of McGill's finest and has served the University well during its plus 80 years.
