Department of Civil Engineering and Applied Mechanics

B.Eng.; Minor in Environmental Engineering (21 cr.)

The Committee reviewed a response received from Professor Subhasis Ghoshal, which stated it is the norm in the Faculty of Engineering for minors to have up to 12 credits that may be double counted. Professor Chouinard commented that only a certain group of students will need to take 9 credits of new courses in the minor. Dr. Crago commented that majors in Engineering are higher in credits due to the professional board's requirements. Also, it was noted that many Engineering programs are over 100 credits.

Dr. Crago commented that CREPUQ requires course and program reviews at universities. She indicated that when McGill performs this review, it will be a good opportunity for the University to review the different practices for the same terms used throughout the University. In the case of minors in the Faculty of Engineering, it is more the question of using the term minors for these programs rather than the double counting of credits issue. Professor Drury suggested that the Faculty review what is done in other Canadian universities for Engineering minors.
