^{*}Students who fast tracked from the MSc to the PhD program do not need to repeat these courses if they have already completed them.

^{**}In the Department of Anatomy and Cell Biology, students must complete the comprehensive exam no later than their 18th month of study, and they must register for the course in the term in which they intend to complete the exam. For example; if a student plans to have their comprehensive exam in February, they must register for ANAT 701 by the add/drop deadline for the winter registration period, or else they will be charged late registration fees. The 18th month falls in the summer term for students who have been admitted during the winter term. Since the department does not offer summer courses, if a student wishes to take the comprehensive exam during the summer term, they must first consult with their supervisor, and then contact the Graduate Program Coordinator for special registration permission.
