News from the MUHC Prehabilitation Clinic

The MUHC Prehabilitation Clinic

has been officially functioning since October 2021 and is open daily at the Montreal General Hospital. It receives referrals from surgeons and internists, and works closely with the Preoperative Clinic and the Central Operating Room Booking (CORB). In addition, there is an active research program with projects funded by CIHR, ESPEN, MITACS, Rossy Cancer Network, the Louise and Alan Edwards Foundation for Research on Pain, the Canadian Donation and Transplantation Research Program, and the Canadian Association for the Study of Liver.

The Prehabilitation Clinic collaborates with the McGill School of Nutrition and the Department of Kinesiology. Currently, four graduate students (2 PhD and 2 MSc) are supervised by members of the Clinic.
