At a meeting on October 13th, 2016, APC reviewed and approved a proposal from the Faculty of Medicine to create a School of Population and Global Health (SPGH). Historically, public health interventions have contributed to most major advances in the health of populations. Now more than ever, new challenges such as climate change or pandemics have proven the need for a global approach to public health matters. The School of Population and Global Health will build on McGill's strong expertise in Population and Global Health and bring the current expertise, all dispersed over numerous units, in one place. Faculty members from Medicine, Arts, Law, Agricultural and Environmental Sciences, Education, Engineering, Management and Science will collaborate to train public and population health researchers, practitioners and decision makers, conduct high impact research and engage in knowledge translation and exchange. The creation of the SPGH will bring more opportunities for interdisciplinary research and increase access to funding, scholarships and philanthropy. The SGPH will enhance the University's capacity to make significant contributions to the health and wellbeing of populations worldwide while increasing McGill's reputation and visibility in the public domain.
