

The values listed below are the lowest grades used for admission for September 2016; grades that are equal to or better than those listed do not guarantee admission for September 2017. Admission to McGill is competitive and subject to availability of space. As such, the minimum overall R Score required for entry may fluctuate up or down by as 2.0 points or more in any given year.

McGill reviews CEGEP applications for admission based on the overall cote R as determined by the Ministry as well as a core average of any prerequisite courses calculated by the Admissions Office. All results are taken into consideration, including those for any failed or repeated courses. The courses used in calculating the core average differ depending on the program to which you have applied. For example, a science core average includes all 101 biology, 201 mathematics, 202 chemistry, and 203 physics. Please consult our website for more information on prerequisite courses.

Normally, McGill uses all CEGEP grades (the *CRC globale*) into consideration in making its competitive admission decisions. Unlike some other universities in Quebec, McGill does not use the *CRC par programme*. Nonetheless, *applicants* who have switched from one CEGEP program to another and whose performance has improved significantly after the switch, are welcome to highlight this by checking the "extenuating circumstances" box on the application and by providing a personal statement about their CEGEP experiences. In exceptional cases, the McGill decision may be based on a selection of CEGEP grades. Please note that the extenuating circumstances box may also be used to flag other issues (health, personal and other) deemed to have negatively affected the academic performance of an applicant
