
ARCH 325/680 2022 - Workshops

Workshop 1 - THEME: contour drawing + subject, not object

Media: soft pencil, pencil/ink sketchbook (NOT watercolour paper)

- Part 1: 60 minutes minimum 20 quick studies of subjects, not objects
 - 1. Divide a 9 x 12 inch sketchbook page into 6 or 8 framed thumbnails. Use masking tape or draw with your pencil, but make sure that each thumbnail is defined by its own frame. In other words, if you *draw* the frame, use a double line to subdivide the page.





- 2. Make a series of 16-20 drawings, 2-3 minutes each contour (line) only, NO SHADING
- 3. Work quickly start by 'claiming' the boundaries: left to right (eg, horizon line), top to bottom (eg, the vertical line of a telephone pole, a flagpole, a tree, a chimney or the corner of a building)
- 4. Develop the drawing in layers and push the drawing to the edges **FILL THE FRAME** if you find yourself stuck in the centre, on an object like a fire hydrant or a park bench, go back to the subject and find cues that will allow you to take the drawing out to the boundary, for example, a telephone wire, a shadow, a crack in the asphalt, the path of a seagull flying across the page...
- 5. Concentrate on not thinking about what things are, or what you think is important. Treat space as solid. Take the 'labels' away by 'labels', we mean words like car, tree, house, window, and so on...

Part 2: 30 minutes - same, but larger thumbnails, longer studies - 7 1/2 minutes each

- 1. Divide the pages into 4 framed thumbnails
- 2. Develop 4 studies, same strategy, contour PLUS crosshatch for values (shade and shadow)


Part 3: 30 minutes – same, larger thumbnails, **15** minutes each

- 1. Divide the page into 2 framed thumbnails
- 2. Develop 2 studies, same strategy, contour and crosshatch

Workshop 2 - THEME: subject, not object + light and shade Media: pencil and wash, watercolours, watercolour paper/pad

Part 1: 60 minutes – 2 studies @ 30 minutes each, based on Workshop 1, but with the addition of a neutral (grey) wash mixed with BURNT UMBER and FRENCH ULTRAMARINE

Part 2: 60 minutes – 2 studies @ 30 minutes each, based on the 'Tondino' format with the page divided to create areas for a small thumbnail at the upper left, a test strip and the large finished study – do the thumbnail first, with contour, crosshatching and loose wash



Workshop 3 - THEME: subject, not object + light and shade + colour Media: pencil and watercolour, watercolour paper/pad

Part 1: 60 minutes - 2 sketches based on Workshop 2, Part 2, with a 3rd colour added

Part 2: 60 minutes – 2 more sketches, with a 4th colour added... then a 5th
