<b>POSITION:</b>	Eco-citizenship Education Intern - Remote Internship
<b>LOCATION:</b>	Montreal, Quebec
<b>DESCRIPTION OF HOST ORGANIZATION:</b>	Social Justice Connection is an independent organization providing education about human rights, eco-citizenship and global inequality. SJC offers unique and engaging educational tools and interactive workshops to schools, NGOs and community groups.
<b>INTERN'S DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Participating in project management, such as promoting workshops to help recruiting participants.</li> <li>- Assisting staff in research and development of new educational tools.</li> <li>- Collecting data and compiling it to support the workshop's pilot phase.</li> <li>- Improving our services to support groups in marginalized situations</li> </ul> <p><i>Interns' duties and projects may not be as listed. These will depend on the needs of the host organization.</i></p>
<b>HOST ORGANIZATION'S REQUIREMENTS:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- High interest in public education, social justice and ecology.</li> <li>- Courses in education, communication, political science, or ecology.</li> <li>- Fluent French written and oral</li> <li>- Very good internet research skills.</li> <li>- Must be outgoing and highly motivated.</li> <li>- Prior experience in popular education and/or teaching is an asset.</li> <li>- Prior working or volunteering experience with NGOs and/or community organizations is an asset.</li> </ul>
<b>HOURS:</b>	3 Days Per Week
<b>DATES:</b>	<b>June 21 – August 27, 2021</b>
<b>REMUNERATION:</b>	\$3,000 CAD issued through a Faculty of Arts Internship Award.

<b>CITIZENSHIP REQUIREMENTS:</b>	
<b>ELIGIBILITY:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- McGill Faculty of Arts students (B.A., B.A &amp; Sc., BSW, B.Th., M.A, MSW)</li> <li>- Minimum CGPA of 2.7</li> <li>- Returning to McGill in the fall semester following the internship</li> <li>- Students must fulfill Faculty of Arts requirements as outlined in the Handbook for Interns <a href="https://www.mcgill.ca/arts-internships/resources">https://www.mcgill.ca/arts-internships/resources</a> (under General Resources -&gt; Handbook)</li> </ul>
<b>COSTS:</b>	The intern is responsible for all costs associated with the internship including transportation, accommodations, etc.
<b>TRAVEL ARRANGEMENTS:</b>	Preparing travel arrangements to and from the internship host organization is the responsibility of the intern.
<b>ACCOMMODATION:</b>	Preparing travel arrangements to and from the internship host organization is the responsibility of the intern.

<b>ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:</b>	Interns are responsible for informing themselves of what entry requirements are required to visit and work as an intern in the internship host country. These may include a visa, work permit, passport valid for at least 6 months after entry, and proof of certain vaccinations. <u>The intern is responsible for acquiring all necessary documents in time for the beginning of their internship.</u>
