This award supports research travel for archival research or fieldwork lasting at least one (1) semester/term. The research or fieldwork must be directly required to complete the MA-Thesis or PhD program.

### Eligibility Criteria:

You must be are traveling outside Canada for archival research or fieldwork for a duration of at least one (1) month. Travel must take place before April 30, 2024.

You must be registered as a full-time MA-Thesis or PhD student in the Faculty of Arts at the time of application.

You must be a returning student who will register full-time in your program for at least one (1) semester upon completion of your travel.

You are required to disclose any travel-related funding that you might have obtained or applied for the proposed fieldwork or archival research and explain why the funding requested from the Schull Yang program is necessary for your project.
