**Dr. Phillippe Seguin** is an Associate Professor, and Chair in the Department of Plant Science, McGill University. He is a specialist on the management, physiology, and ecology of field crops. His research deals mainly with the use and development of legume crops for nutraceutical production and the evaluation of forage species to be used as feed for dairy cattle. He is also involved in the evaluation of new crop species for use in Quebec.
