1. Further Input from the Community [CR18-13]

The Committee discussed the comments from members of the McGill community received since the April 17, 2019 meeting of CAMSR. The comments were submitted in response to an invitation issued on the CAMSR [webpage](#) and through the whatsnew@mcgill bulletin.

2. Evolution of SRI Trends: An Introduction [CR18-14 and CR18-12]

The Committee received reports on socially responsible investment (SRI) initiatives at Canadian and international universities (with particular attention to McGill's peer group, the U15). The Committee reviewed the status of divestment decisions and campaigns and the general trend within the university sector towards establishing socially responsible investment policies and practices, including through the creation of sustainable investment funds. The Committee also received information pertaining to a number of not-for-profit organizations. It will continue its work on this file at its next meeting in June 2019.

Professor Christopher Buddle and Mr. Nicholas Dunn, representatives of Senate appointed by Senate to participate in CAMSR's consultation sessions, attended this portion of the meeting.
