
- McGill's Strategic Academic Plan (2017-2022) committed the University to several enrolment targets as part of its key objectives:
 - Increase the number of applications and the yield rate from all Québec CEGEPs and collèges;
 - Increase the number of new registrations from Francophone CEGEPs and collèges by 15%;
 - Increase Indigenous student enrolment to 1,000;
 - Maintain international student enrolment at 25-30% of the total undergraduate population; and
 - Continue to attract top graduate students from around the world.

Average R Score of New Registrations: <u>All</u> CEGEPs and collèges








SAP Priority: Increase the number of new registrations from Francophone Québec CEGEPS and collèges by 15%.

Average R Score of New Registrations: Francophone CEGEPs and collèges








Indigenous students Academic Year (total) Fall enrolment only


Indigenous student enrolment, all programs Note: Winter 2024 and summer 2024 enrolment not yet available



Indigenous student enrolment, excluding Office of First Nations and Inuit Education (OFNIE) programs



Undergraduate enrolment: Domestic and International students




Total number of countries represented by International students



Doctoral new registrations: International and domestic students






Total enrolment by Level of Study

Undergraduate enrolment by Level of Study


