## **BECOME A MENTOR:**

As a mentor, you will:

1/ Meet with your mentee at times that are convenient for both of you.

2/ Plan your mentoring sessions with the support of the Indigenous Community Outreach Ambassadors. Sessions are dedicated to supporting your mentee with the exploration of their interests, and the next steps in their education and career paths.

3/ Attend mentors' training sessions and participate in culturally relevant workshops, activities, and talks.

4/ Assist your mentee in the creation of their final project which should aim to answer the question "What are the next steps in my educational path?"

## **Eligible mentors:**

1/ Have a mentorship mindset and good interpersonal skills

2/ Are naturally inclined to connect with other students and provide help as needed

3/ Are patient, sympathetic and resourceful

4/ Are cooperative and willing to follow up with the program assistant on a regular basis

5/ Representation being a key component of this program, Indigenous McGill students are strongly encouraged to apply.

*Mentors will receive a monetary award and a letter of attestation from the Dean of Students for their participation.*
