PART 1 GENERAL

1.1 Summary

.1 Unless otherwise indicated, follow the standards below when specifying asphalt paving. These standards are not intended to restrict or replace professional judgment.

1.2 Design Requirements

- .1 Asphalt is not a preferred surfacing option. Alternative materials should be considered for high-profile areas, walkways and bike paths. Refer to:
 - .1 **03 30 00** Cast in place concrete.
 - .2 **31 35 00** Natural Stone.
 - .3 **32 14 15** Prefabricated Unit Paving.
- .2 Downtown Campus
 - .1 Lower campus
 - .1 Asphalt is strongly discouraged. It may be considered for very low-profile service areas or laneways, or temporary installations (less than three years).
 - .2 Upper campus
 - .1 Asphalt can be considered for low profile areas or temporary installations (less than three years), roadways and parking areas only.
