PART 1 General

1.1 Summary

.1 Unless otherwise indicated, follow the standards below when specifying seeding (mechanical or hydraulic). These standards are not intended to restrict or replace professional judgment.

1.2 Design Requirements

- .1 Seeding (mechanical or hydraulic) for turf are not generally considered by McGill as viable options, due to heavy traffic on its campuses.
- .2 Downtown Campus
 - .1 Mechanical seeding is not allowed (newly turfed areas).
 - .2 Hydraulic seeding is strongly discouraged. It may be considered in severely sloped areas where sod establishment would be difficult, in which case the area needs to be well protected from traffic and wear.
- .3 MacDonald Campus
 - .1 Mechanical and hydraulic seeding may be considered in large and/or low-profile areas with no traffic and wear potential, where sodding would be cost-prohibitive, in which case the area still needs to be protected from traffic.
 - .2 Hydraulic seeding may also be considered in severely sloped areas where sod establishment would be difficult, in which case the area needs to be well protected from traffic and wear.
