PART 1 GENERAL

1.1 Summary

.1 Unless otherwise indicated, follow the standards below when specifying Crushed Stone Surfacing. These standards are not intended to restrict or replace professional judgment.

1.2 Design Requirements

- .1 Stabilized screening surfaces may be considered for the following:
 - .1 At the Downtown, MacDonald and Gault campuses, for informal areas where turf or equivalent is desired but the high volume of traffic makes turf impractical.
 - .1 No visible borders shall be used. A seamless transition is desired into adjoining turf areas.
 - .2 At the MacDonald Campus, for low-profile, pedestrian-only, service areas or pathways
 - .3 At the Gault Campus, for pedestrian-only, service areas or pathways
- .2 Crushed stone or gravel surfaces
 - .1 Are only permitted at the Gault Campus, where appropriate.

PART 2 PRODUCTS

2.1 Stabilized Screening

- .1 Granitic screening: Refer to section **31 05 16** Aggregate Materials.
- .2 Stabilizer: shall be manufactured by Agrebec or approved equivalent.

3.1 Stabilized Screening

.1 Work shall be done according to the manufacturers' recommendations.
