## Arriving at Centennial Centre

## Arriving at the Career Fair

There will be two tables before entering the ballroom.

1. "Registration" Table: Our friendly volunteers will register you for the career fair and supply you with a name tag which you can fill out with your preferred name. You may also include your area of study (e.g. "Food Science" or "Bachelor: Food Science").

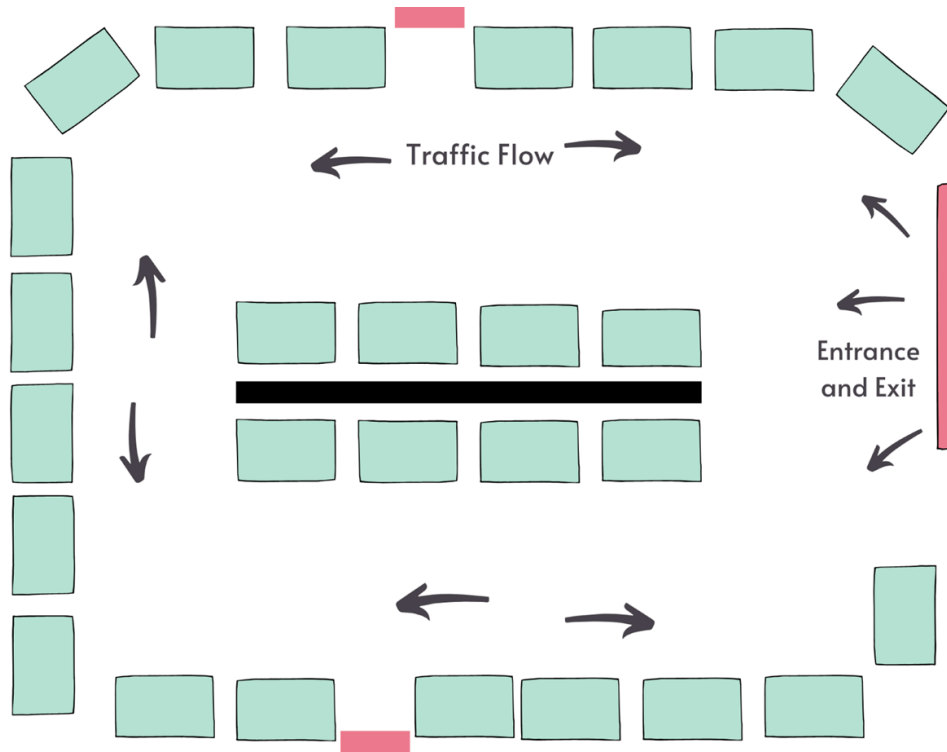
## Inside the Ballroom

## **Floor Plan**

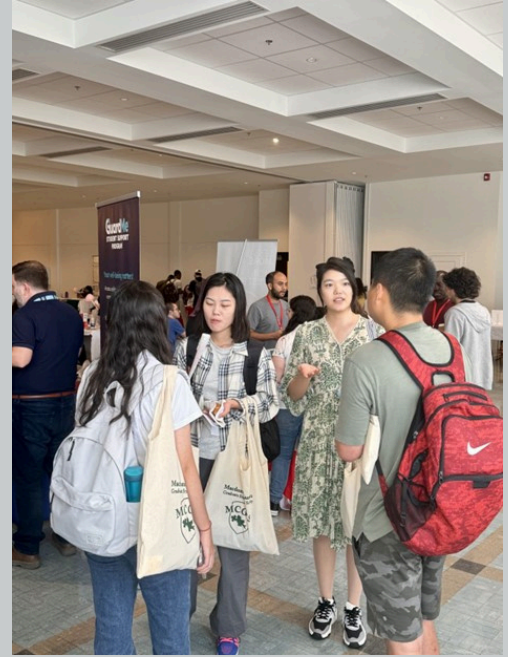
