Grant application

The 2015 call for proposals aims to further enhance GEPROM's focus on understanding the molecular basis of disease and strengthening translation research within the group. Therefore, priority will be given to projects that have a clear translational component or are directly linked to a disease. The projects should be distinct from any operating grants currently held by the applicants including current funding from GÉPROM.

The competition is open to all regular members of GÉPROM. Each regular member can submit only <u>one</u> application. Individual grants will be funded at \$10K/grant with team grants of 2 at \$15K/grant and 3 or more at \$20K/grant. Funding should be expended by June 2016.
