He has held several senior global health positions including Principal Advisor for Health, Population and Nutrition at CIDA, Chief of Health at UNICEF and Coordinator of the Maternal Health Thematic Fund at UNFPA. He wrote the first global malaria strategy and was instrumental in setting up the Global Alliance for Vaccines and Immunization and the Global Fund to Fight Aids, TB and Malaria.
