Date: Saturday, January 25, 2020

Cost: **\$400 plus tax (\$460) per team*** payable in Canadian dollars to McGill University. Send your payment to the above address (I can send you an official invoice once you confirm your number of teams).

**Included in your fees is the cost of wood, awards, officiating, team breakfast, team lunch, and grab-and-go dinner during the awards. The awards will take place in the Centennial Centre following the competition.*

Register your team by Friday, January 10, 2020 by using the online registration form (one form per team) found at <http://cilawoodsmen.ca/forms/registration-form-competitions>. A more detailed itinerary will be sent to you in early January.

Meals RSVP: *I have to confirm numbers for meals, so let me know if your teams are attending breakfast and/or lunch. Members requiring a meal option please email me by **December 20, 2019**. If we know in advance we can offer a vegetarian version of our meals however, because of the kitchen layout, we cannot offer allergen free meals. We can arrange the following if necessary: No ingredient containing nuts; No ingredient containing peanuts; Limit Gluten.*

The competition t-shirts and raffle tickets will be on sale, and once again our Food Science students will run the Bistro/ Snack Bar in the Ceilidh. Fresh coffee, snacks and light lunches will be on sale at reasonable prices for spectators.

Your team info package with meal tickets will be handed out at the Captain's Meeting which will take place on Friday, January 24th at 8:30 pm in the Centennial Centre (right next to the Watson Field).

This year marks our 60th anniversary of our competition, so we will be having a special **Alumni & Spares relay event** directly after the competition. Stay tuned for more details!
