Brief course description:

CHEM 212 Lab/CHEM 224 aims to equip you with skills that will help you make the most of your university education. This course will encompass a range of activities that focus on how to find useful information in the scientific literature, how to assess risks and hazards when working with chemicals and hazardous waste, how to communicate results effectively to a range of different audiences, how to work collaboratively with your peers, and how to assess and promote sustainable actions. Activities will draw on content from the CHEM 212/211 lecture.

Method of Delivery:

Content (slides, resources, pre-recorded videos) will be available on myCourses. Access to a lab simulator will also be provided. Live sessions with graduate student TAs will occur on a weekly basis within the scheduled lab session times.

Evaluation Scheme:

The CHEM 212 lab component counts for 20% of the overall CHEM 212 course grade. CHEM 224 is open to students who have the lecture equivalent of CHEM 212 (CHEM 211).

Students will select from a range of activities to complete.

All course components will be graded on a pass/fail basis.
