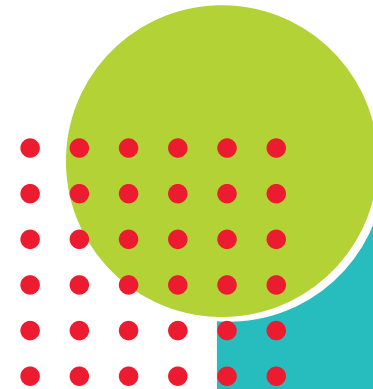

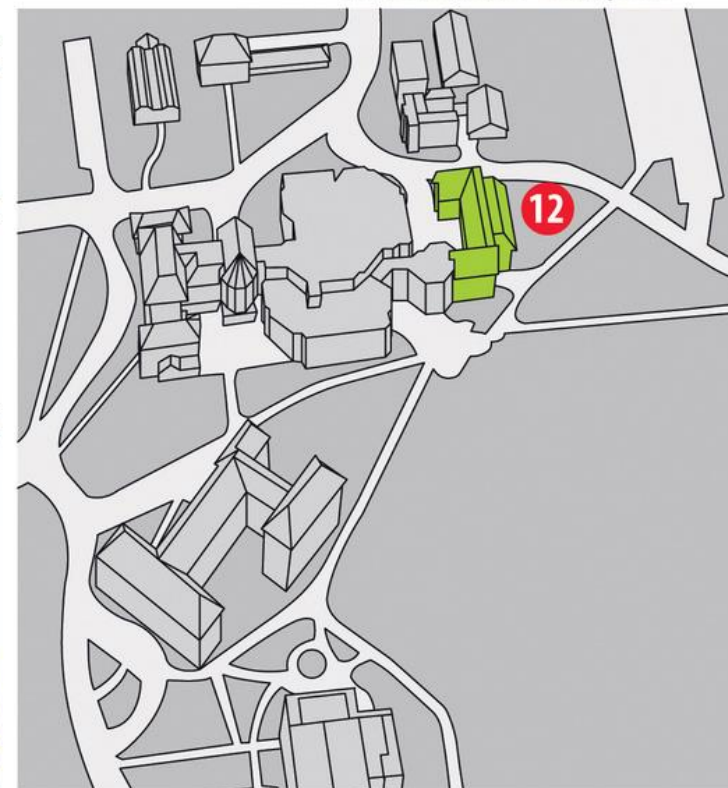
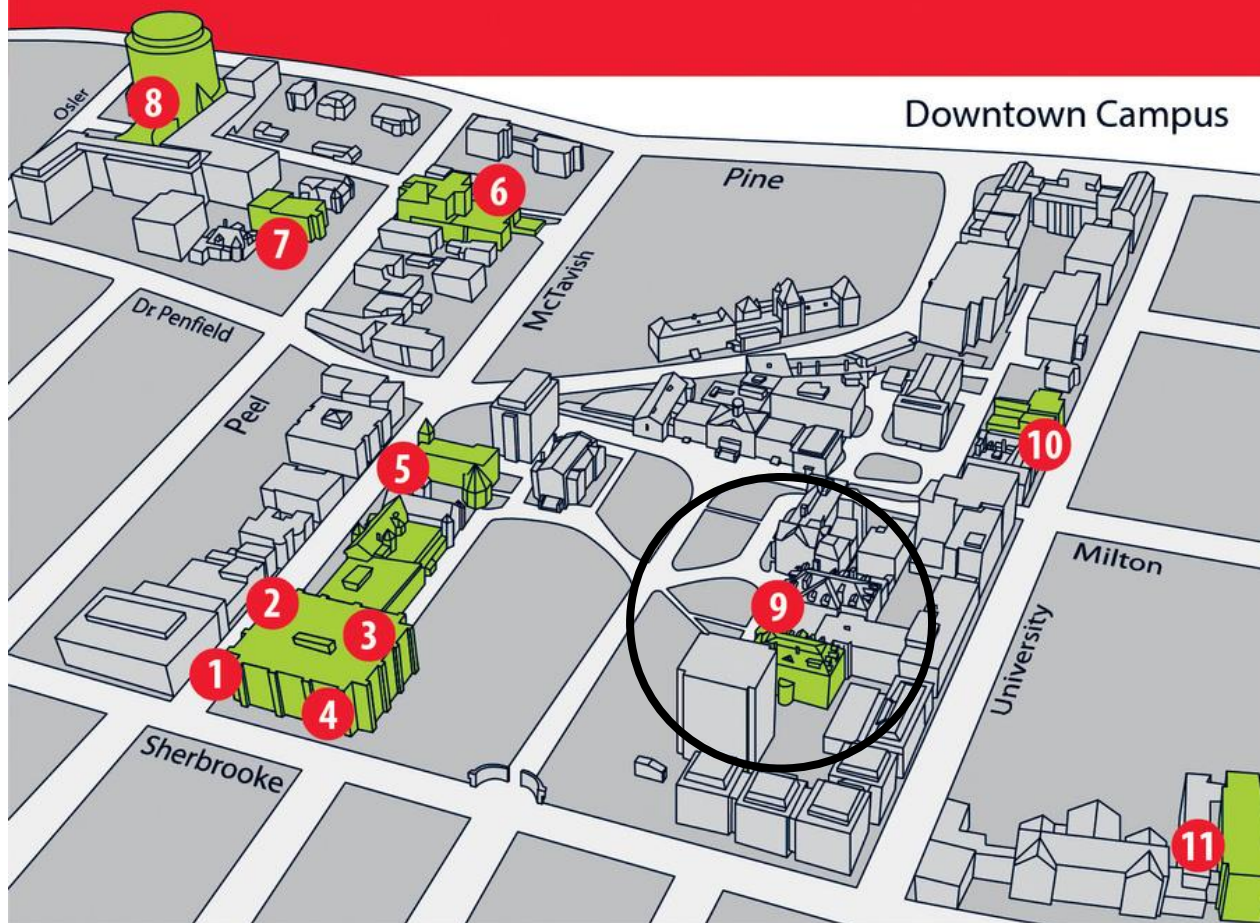

WITH THIS NEW LIBRARY APP

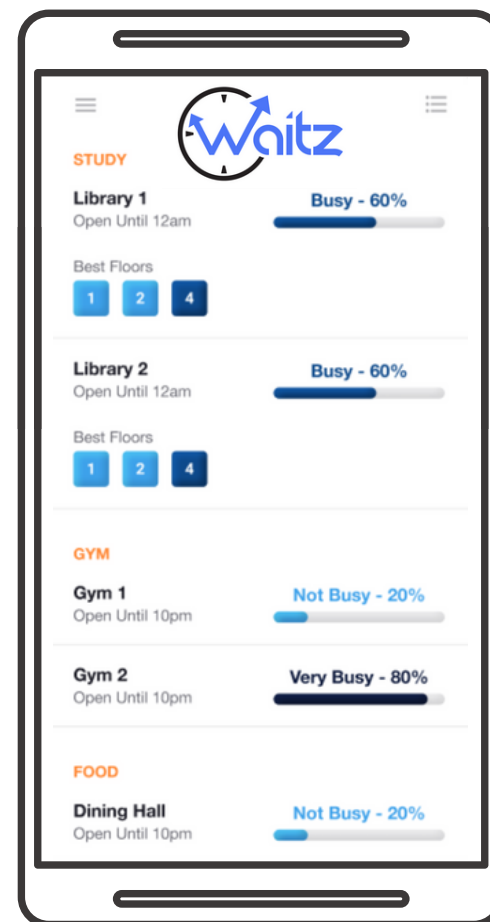
Introducing Waitz: the anonymous space use app.
