Guidelines for the 24th Annual CEGSS Conference

- The 24th Annual CEGSS Conference is held annually by McGill's Civil Engineering Graduate Student Society (CEGSS).
- The conference is an excellent opportunity to present your ongoing research and to get acquainted with your peers at McGill and other universities in Canada.
- The conference is held primarily in English, but English and French submissions are welcome.
- No written papers are required. All you need is:

1) Provide us with an abstract by **April 15th, 2017**.

2) Prepare your PowerPoint presentation or Poster to present at the conference.

- Presentations are welcome from all Civil Engineering disciplines (i.e. structural, transportation, environmental, and geotechnical engineering).
- Oral presentations given by graduate students are 12-15 minutes long.
- Research posters of any size are welcome.
- Lunch, snacks and coffee breaks are included during the conference.
- Significant cash prizes are given to best overall presentations and posters.

Abstract guidelines:

- All text should be in Times New Roman. The title SHOULD be size 14 and bold.
- All other text SHOULD be size 12.
- Author names, department and contact information MUST be written.
- Page margins SHOULD be 1 inch and all text SHOULD be centrally justified.
