PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY

Applicants interested in participating in this Initiative, must meet the following eligibility criteria:

- Be 21 years of age or older in order to be admitted as mature student
- Provide proof of citizenship/residency status in Canada
- Submit all documentation requested on this Candidate Application Form.
- Completion of a French language placement test provided by the School of Continuing Studies upon receipt of this application form. Please note, priority will be given to those candidates who score a minimum of low-intermediate proficiency level (e.g., equivalent to A2 on the CEFR scale, or level 3-4 of francisation).

LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY

Proof of English proficiency is not required for the PDC. However, since the language of instruction is English, a good command of English is required to perform well in courses and complete the program.
