- 7 January: Courses begin. Deadline to transfer or cancel a course with full refund. Course deleted from record.

- 29 January: Deadline to apply for a refund **LESS \$20**. Withdrawal grade of "W" will appear on record; not included in GPA.
- 9 March: Deadline to withdraw from Winter Courses. **NO REFUND**. Grade of "W"; not included in GPA.
- After March 9:** **NO refund, NO withdrawals.** Unexcused Absence "**J**" (failed); the student is registered for a course but does not write the final examination and/or do required work; calculated as a failure in the GPA and CGPA.
