

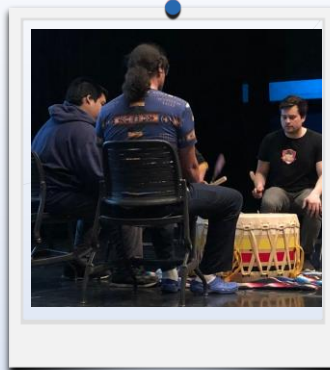

On June 17 and 18, 2019, we had the pleasure of hosting the 3rd annual Complex Trauma Symposium. Day 1 workshops included topics specific to trauma-focused cognitive therapy, vicarious trauma, and E-health technologies; Day 2 topics included trauma-informed classrooms and schools, front line approaches for treating trauma, and occupational therapy approaches for cases of child complex trauma. Importantly, participants not only had opportunities to attend interactive and engaging workshops but were also able to network during social breaks and community-build during a cocktail hour hosted on the first day of the symposium.
