Abstract guidelines and formatting instructions

- Please submit your abstract in a Microsoft Word compatible format, saved under your name (SmithJim_Abtract_RD2016.doc);
- 250 words maximum (not including the title or authors);
- Insert a margin of 2.54 cm (1 inch) around the page;
- Use Times 12 point font, black ink, six lines per inch, no condensed type or spacing;
- The title should be in bold and all caps;
- Clearly indicate all authors as well as their affiliations;
- Indicate funding sources, as required.
