

## Important Time Sensitive Information

### IMMIGRATION REQUIREMENTS FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

International students (non-Canadian and non-permanent residents of Canada) are required to obtain a Certification d'Acceptation du Québec (CAQ) from the Ministère de l'immigration, de la Diversité et de l'inclusion (Québec), and a Study Permit from Citizenship and Immigration Canada (CIC) in order to study legally at McGill University. **When applying for your Student Permit with Canada, you will also need to apply for a “co-op work permit” as the D.M.D. program has required clinical rotations not comprising more than 50% of the program credits. All students must complete these clinical courses to obtain the Doctor of Dental Medicine (D.M.D.) degree.** Detailed immigration procedures are provided on the International Students Services website at [www.mcgill.ca/internationalstudents](http://www.mcgill.ca/internationalstudents).

Immigration officials require a copy of the admission letter along with a copy of this supplemental document to provide an estimate of the cost and duration of the studies. Note that a medical exam from a CIC certified physician is required for healthcare students. ### INTERNATIONAL TUITION FEES

International students admitted to the **Doctor of Dental Medicine (D.M.D.) program** of the Faculty of Dental Medicine and Oral Health Sciences of McGill University should expect the following approximate annual costs:

The D.M.D. program is a four-year program, only offered full time and runs in an academic year of August to June.
