DOM Council met Wednesday Jan 6th. Highlights including reviewing the **new** "**PEM rules**" which provide much needed physician workforce flexibility including for leaves (maternity, parental, sabbatical), pre-retirement plans (63+ half-time 2 year off PEM contract, 65+ 20% time indefinite off PEM contract), moonlighting (CMQ licensed trainees can do up to 1 day per week) and more. Ask your Division Director for more details. Council approved Dr. Kahn's Year 1 Associate Chair **Research plans** (show casing and tracking research success, clinician scientist pipeline programs and more) and Dr. Dayan's Year 1 Associate Chair **Wellness plans** (pilot DOM mentorship program and more).
