Program Schedule

- The program begins around May 1st duration of 16 months
- The two summers are full time:
 - You won't have time to work either summer
 - 1st summer ends around July 20 in 2021
- Fall classes 2 nights/week
- Winter term no classes

Our Classes

- Class size is limited to ~55 students

Base Camp

- Optional Base Camp in the 1st summer & fall (\$250)
 - ✓ A full day Case Skills Seminar & and a full day Presentation Skills Seminar
 - ✓ Three individual coaching sessions over the course of the summer & fall terms
 - Helps students make the transition to Case Based Learning
 - Strongly recommended!
 - Scholarships available to the top applicants to cover the cost





Capstone 1 (Integrative course)

- Includes a group project & presentation
- All students across Canada get the same large comprehensive case at the same time.
- Get 8 weeks to do a strategic analysis and prepare a presentation to be delivered to a "board" of the company.
- Purpose: to develop professional & team skills and to integrate all competencies (see CPA Competency slide).
- At McGill we start doing comprehensive cases & group presentations in the 1st courses. Develop & integrate enabling skills from the start!





GCPA Program - Costs

Average \$2,061.96 regular tuition fees for Quebec residents (24 credit program; \$84.40/credit – \$20; \$87.43/credit – F20 term, plus \$21).

Per credit fees changes every semester. Other fees & charges do apply.

- \$250* Base Camp offered at start of the program to help you bridge the gap from undergraduate to CPA style learning
- \$2,000* CFE Prep course in final summer (*subject to change)
- \$615.12 Registration with the Order. CPP annual dues \$431.16.
- \$1161.25 Examination software & educational material access fee
- \$1,810.86 CFE Registration

- Some of the fees may be reimbursed by your employer





CFE Prep Seminar (\$) (Capstone 2)

- Program in the 2nd summer leading to the exam in September
- Focuses on case writing techniques and integration of knowledge acquired through the program
- Weekly one-on-one debriefs with graders (recent writers) and group debriefs with other students
- Three-day Mock CFE in July
- Passing grade for the seminar
