DOCUMENT CHECKLIST ITEMS TO BE SUBMITTED ONLINE:

- Graduate On-Line Application**
- Application Fee**
The application fee is C\$113.27 paid by credit card at the time of application.
- Essay Questions**
In one document, complete the essay questions and upload as a PDF.
- Curriculum Vitae.**
Upload as a PDF.
- Reference Letters**
On the application form you must provide the names and email addresses of **two** referees who can evaluate your abilities. You may send the recommendation form to the referee for completion or the referee may choose to write their own recommendation letter. Once your application has been submitted, McGill will automatically contact these referees and invite them to upload the references. **Note:** *Referees may upload their reference letter in PDF or Word document.*
- Transcripts**
Upload your complete record of study from each university-level institution you have attended to date and listed on your application. The transcripts must include courses and grades for each year attended. For those universities/institutions where a degree has been obtained, however the year it is not stated on the transcripts, we would require a copy of the degree awarded and this must be uploaded along with the transcripts. Uploaded copies are considered unofficial, therefore final official transcripts will be required once you have been extended an offer of admission. *McGill transcripts need not be uploaded.*
- Graduate Management Admissions Test (GMAT) or Graduate Record Examination (GRE) Score (if required)**
When registering for the test please ensure that you request the results be sent directly to McGill University, GMAT Institution Code: 58H-MN-66; GRE Institution Code: 0935. McGill will then receive the results electronically, directly from the testing agency.
- Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) Score (if required)**
When registering for the test please ensure that you request the results be sent directly to McGill University, Code: 0935. McGill will then receive the results electronically, directly from the testing agency.
