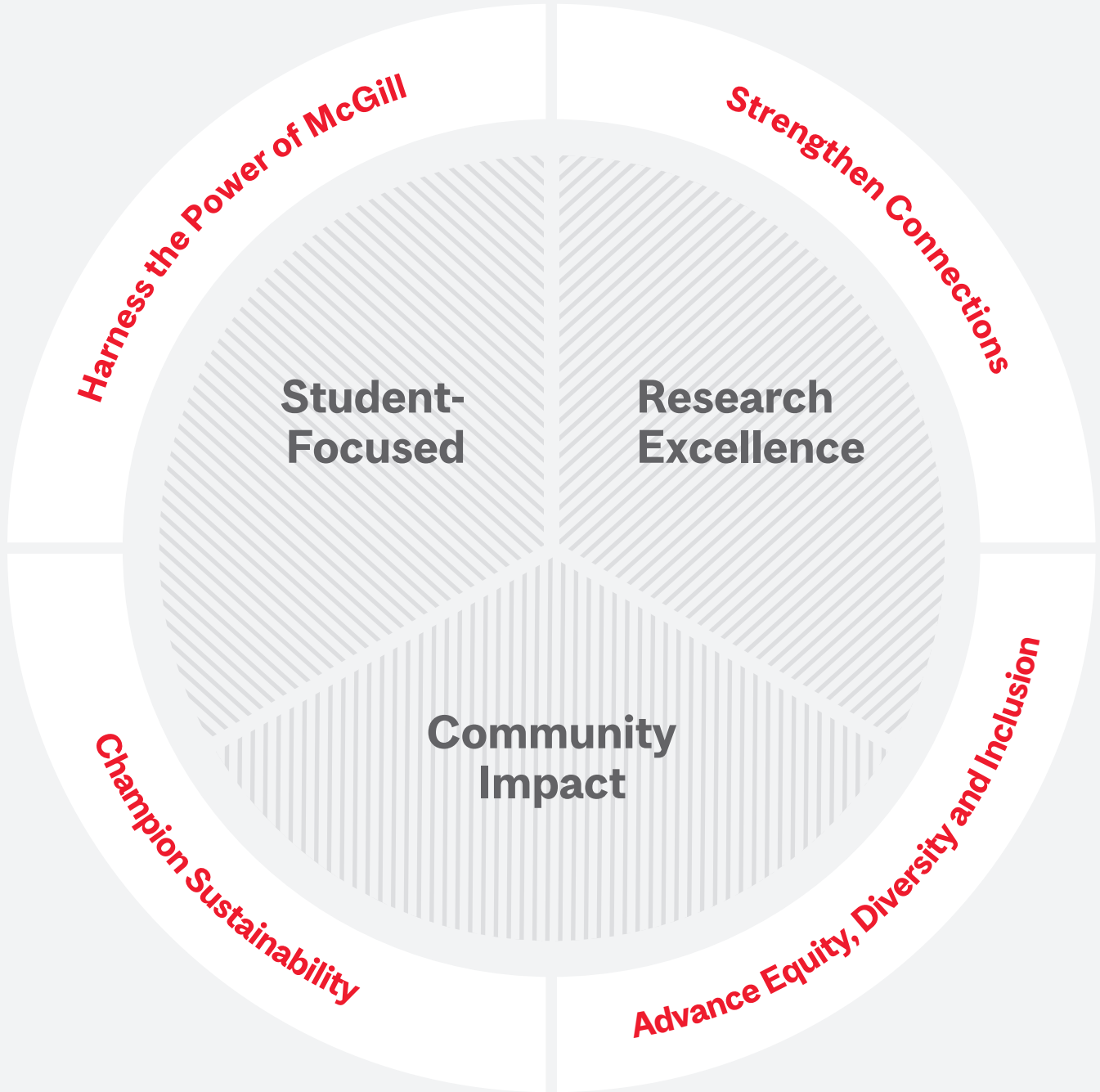

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# Core priorities

In executing our primary mission and achieving our vision as an institution of higher learning, we are committed to:

## *Students-Focused*

**Providing an outstanding learning experience for all students through high-impact programs that provide access to experiential learning and build foundational skills in critical and creative thinking and problem solving.**

- **Update existing curricula and co-curricular experiences:**  
Expand and curate experiential learning opportunities; continue to build up data literacy, logic and coding support; and enrich student learning through online and hybrid delivery methods.
- **Enhance the student experience:**  
Provide an enriched cohort experience in all programs and exceptional student services through a new hub that integrates academic and career advising and mental health support services.

## *Research Excellence*

**Cementing Desautels' reputation as a world-leading management faculty, through the rigor and relevance of our research.**

- **Strengthen the support for faculty research:**  
Balance the roles and obligations of faculty members with regards to research, teaching, administration and outreach, and link rewards accordingly.
- **Increase influence and integration of research:**  
Communicate the impact and relevance of our research to individuals and organizations, better facilitate the integration of research into the student experience, and pursue industry research partnerships.

## *Community Impact*

**Being the engine of social and economic value creation among university, local, national and international communities, through the application of Desautels' research, expertise, and talent.**

Expand our capacity of entrepreneurship for university and community outreach, engage with and communicate initiatives by students, alumni, faculty and staff in terms of their community impact, and enhance industry collaboration.

Improve the work environment through organizational and process improvements, more integration and co-learning, and by facilitating communication and transparency among faculty, students, and staff.

# Transversal themes

**Over the next five years, Desautels further commits to augment student experiences, research excellence and community impact by activating new initiatives and enhancing existing ones that:**

## *Harness the Power of McGill*

- Establish a data reasoning analytics lab, initially geared toward supporting student projects with qualitative and quantitative components, and scaling to support faculty research and engagement activities.
- Lead and enable systematic Desautels participation in large-scale initiatives in domains where Desautels can make important contributions, has enabling infrastructure and facilities, can welcome multi-faculty stakeholder activity, and can contribute to institutional partnerships and associations.
- Increase accessibility for students to take academic courses across McGill faculties by resolving demand and cross-registration issues, and facilitating the development of new joint courses or programs with McGill colleagues.

## *Strengthen Connections*

- Experiment with and offer exceptional online and hybrid learning and social experiences for students, faculty, staff and friends of Desautels.
- Expand learning opportunities, for example, through experiential learning, by providing more exposure to local (Montreal/Canadian) industry and societal challenges, expanding the range of short-term study abroad opportunities, increasing student access to meaningful work and volunteer experiences, and better leveraging students' out of class experiences.
- Expand ways faculty research is shared both among researchers within the Desautels community and with external audiences through vehicles like our thought leadership platform, Delve.
- Extend learning opportunities to new audiences with a special emphasis on increasing accessibility and registration of Quebec and Canadian students especially from under-represented communities in academic programs, and leading and building upon existing public education and engagement initiatives.

## *Champion Sustainability*

- Integrate sustainability education in academic programs by emphasizing existing faculty expertise, assisting instructors to mainstream sustainability education, and reinforcing existing sustainability-focused programming.
- Raise internal awareness about sustainability and sustainable development by providing professional development and training support for all faculty and staff, and communicating our sustainability expertise and activities more cohesively.
- Continue to support faculty outputs around sustainability by maintaining a point of contact such as a sustainability committee, resourcing the development of teaching materials, inviting companies and external organizations to speak with faculty about sustainability challenges, and encouraging faculty research in sustainability topics.

## *Advance Equity, Diversity and Inclusion*

Desautels and McGill University are committed to ensuring all members of our community feel safe, welcome, valued and heard. At Desautels a tenured member of the faculty has been appointed as Director of EDI to lead assessment, planning and actions taken at Desautels that raise awareness, create new processes and improve EDI outcomes.

### **Initial actions are to:**

- Establish an EDI infrastructure at Desautels;
- Assess EDI data and experiences of students, faculty and staff;
- Build out a plan with related initiatives based on that analysis.
