**Linguistic and Cultural Adaptation Activities**

Coordinate “conversation cafés” between English-speaking Black students in health and social services programs and French-speaking health care professionals to improve second language skills and bridge cultural and linguistic gaps; more specifically, create opportunities for English-speaking Black students to exchange and connect with French professionals in the health and social service field on subjects related to Black history and culture as it relates to health. First year: Promotion and recruitment strategy implemented. Second year: 3 or 4 events are organized with 5 to 10 participants. Next three years: 6 to 8 events organized with 10 to 15 participants.
