## Health Way - Promotion, Recruiting and Retaining Health Professionals

## **Objectives**

This project aims to support the CISSS de la Gaspésie in recruiting and retaining bilingual health professionals as a means of increasing access to health and social services in English. More precisely, CASA intends to support the CISSS de la Gaspésie in promoting, developing and implementing strategies that support the integration of current and future health professionals into the CISSS and the Baie-des-Chaleurs in general.

## **Description**

To achieve those targets, CASA will organize interactive exchanges between English-speaking health professionals and students by offering lunch chats in two schools annually and one study tour in two schools annually; will continue tracking students by updating and maintaining database; will implement one conversation café\* each year; will share information with the English-speaking population about health sector training, education and retention incentives; will allocate a minimum of 2 bursaries through the Dialogue McGill Health and Social Services Community Leadership Bursary Program. This will be achieved through engaging a project coordinator to develop and maintain the promotion and administration of the Dialogue McGill Bursary Program, as well as to coordinate the development and implementation of other actions.
