Project Title

Community Program to Promote, Recruit and Retain Bilingual Health Care Providers for Mauricie et Centre-du-Québec

Objectives

This program's long-term goal is to increase the number of health care providers who have an understanding of and ability to respond to the needs of the English-speaking community. In so doing the Centre for Access to Services in English (CASE) hopes to ensure that community members have improved access to a range of health and social services in their language.

Description

To reach these goals. CASE will: 1 – work collaboratively with its partners to promote careers in the health and social services to secondary and post-secondary students in the MCQ. Activities will be organized, in partnership with local schools (La Tuque High School, Three Rivers Academy and Shawinigan High School), whereby students will be informed about job opportunities and have occasions to speak with health care professionals about the rewards and challenges of working in the health care field. 2 – adapt existing promotional tools and distribute them to students. 3 – promote and manage the Dialogue McGill Bursary Program and support and assist the students in obtaining internships during their studies to set the ground work for their entry into the workforce. 4 – by meeting with public health partners and being active on relevant committees, will identify existing gaps in the services, and work on strategies that will encourage the recruitment of interns and the hiring of bilingual health care professionals.
