Description

Through Partnerships in Action to Increase Bilingual Resources in the Health and Social Services System in the Greater Quebec City Region, the Jeffery Hale Community Partners (JHCP) will implement, promote and manage the Dialogue McGill Bursary Program for the benefits of English-speaking youth that have an interest in pursuing a career in the health and social services sector after their studies. JHCP will promote the program with the support of all key strategic partners of its community, as well as through English-speaking media. JHCP will also receive and administer all the applications and develop a comprehensive and fair selection process led by a selection committee. Finally, JHCP will ensure that an efficient monitoring process is implemented in order to better track the career path of its bursary recipients throughout the duration of the project.
