**NPMP: Ensemble Today for Better Health Tomorrow**

**Objectives**

To promote intradisciplinary & interdisciplinary clinical knowledge of the French health care language within nursing and with McGill Association of Students in Healthcare (MASH).

**Description**

The Nurse Peer Mentorship Program (NPMP) is a nursing peer mentoring program whose initiative includes wellness workshops as well as bi-weekly French language workshops. Learning French health care terminology in an informal way having peers help you learn will make learning more enjoyable in a safe learning environment. This intradisciplinary approach can be further enhanced by adding an interdisciplinary component to it. In conjunction with MASH – McGill Association of Students in healthcare, meetings will occur every 6-8 weeks where students studying healthcare in the Faculty of Medicine have the opportunity to socialize and learn from each other while acquiring French clinical knowledge. This exchange which promotes interdisciplinary education will help students feel more comfortable conversing in French amongst each other but it will ultimately promote the quality of care and patient safety in healthcare teams.
