



EDUCATOR PRACTITIONER-RESEARCHER GRADUATE AWARD

Call for Applications

Description

The Department of Integrated Studies in Education recognizes and values the importance of connecting research to practice as part of a graduate students' academic dossier. This award recognizes the contributions of one doctoral student and one master's student each year who intend to do, or are in the process of doing, research in the educational setting where they work. This applies to work in both formal/traditional and non-formal/non-traditional settings. An applicant does not need to be actively working or teaching at the time of application, but the aim of this award is to support research that ties directly into the applicant's work context. Applicants are asked to demonstrate benefits of their research to education in their work setting specifically, and to the research literature more generally.

This award is given annually as determined by the Graduate Program Committee. The GPC reserves the right not to make an award.

Amount of award

Minimum value for MA student: \$500; minimum value for PhD student: \$1,000

Eligibility

- All full-time PhD students, MA-thesis students in DISE, regardless of citizenship.
- Students cannot be at or exceed the departmental funding cap, as stipulated in the DISE Funding Guidelines.
- PhD students must have submitted their progress tracking reports at the time of the award submission deadline.



- Students cannot be in a “thesis evaluation” term.
- Preference will be given to students who have not previously received this award.
- **Incomplete applications, late applications or applications that do not adhere to the requirements (e.g., page limits) will not be considered.**

Requirements

Nomination packages must include the following items (All items should be single-spaced, 12-point Times New Roman font, 1-inch margins):

- 1) a summary of the applicant’s research project, its connection to the applicant’s workplace, and benefits. In particular, the letter must include (max. 1 page):
 - a. a brief description of your research project and how it connects with your work in an educational setting; and
 - b. a brief discussion of the benefits of your research to education in this work setting, as well as to the field more generally.
- 2) a list of publications, presentations, workshops, or other ways in which the applicant has either a) disseminated their workplace research to both academic and non-academic audiences or b) demonstrated leadership within their workplace or research field (max. 1 page)
