



## INTERNATIONAL STUDENT EXCELLENCE IN RESEARCH GRADUATE AWARD

### Call for Applications

#### Description

The Department of Integrated Studies in Education recognizes and values the exceptional work of international students in research. This award recognizes the contributions of **four** international doctoral students and **three** international master's students who have demonstrated excellence in research in education. Applicants are asked to demonstrate the contributions of their research to education and to the research literature more generally. This award is given annually as determined by the Graduate Program Committee. The GPC reserves the right not to make an award.

#### Amount of award

Minimum value for MA student: \$500; minimum value for PhD student: \$1,000

Application deadline: November 8<sup>th</sup>, 2023, 11:59 PM

#### Eligibility

- Full-time DISE PhD students and MA-Thesis students.
- Students must have international student status and cannot be Canadian residents or citizens. Preference will be given to MA students in their second or third year of the program and to PhD students in their second, third, fourth, fifth, or sixth years of the program.
- Students cannot be at or exceed the departmental funding cap, as stipulated in the DISE Funding Guidelines.
- PhD students must have submitted their progress tracking reports at the time of the award submission deadline.



- Students cannot be in a “thesis evaluation” term.
- Preference will be given to students who have not previously received this award.
- **Incomplete applications, late applications or applications that do not adhere to the requirements (e.g., page limits) will not be considered.**

## Requirements

**Application packages must include the following items** (All items should be single-spaced, 12-point Times New Roman font, 1-inch margins):

- 1) a research proposal summarizing the applicant’s research project and contributions to the relevant research field and to education including the problem, objectives, methods/methodology (max. 2 pages)
- 2) a document containing a list of the following (max. 4 pages):
  - a. presentations (for both academic and non-academic audiences)
  - b. publications (for both academic and non-academic audiences)
  - c. other research or creative outputs (for both academic and non-academic audiences)
  - d. research experience (e.g., RA-ships) (include a brief description of your role in the project and your contributions)
  - e. awards and honours (when relevant, include the amount of money awarded)
